REMINDER: LEGISLATIVE CALL TO ACTION: Please be advised that the MSFA Legislative Committee has announced a call to action for HB 404. This bill **MUST NOT** be allowed to be signed into law. This bill would negatively impact Fire and EMS and their response to "check the welfare" calls. Although many counties have submitted letters of OPPOSTION, the bill still passed to be signed by the Governor. Our voices MUST be heard on this bill and we ask that ALL counties submit a form letter of opposition. **Please see the attached document** and copy/paste the form letter to your department or county letterhead and forward back to Legislative Chairman Chief Bob Phillips <u>rfcchief48@gmail.com</u> ASAP. The document also includes a copy of a letter that was submitted to the Governor's office last week from leadership across Maryland's fire service.

-This SAFER-funded two-day workshop takes a retention-first approach to help participants evaluate the type of environment they're inviting potential members into and offers keen insight and process improvement from the moment of inquiry, to application and acceptance, and through the onboarding phase. -NOTE: To ensure a personalized experience, the course will be open to a limit of 24 attendees per region (and limited to two people per department) so be sure to register early! This course is for those that are active in their department's retention and recruitment efforts.

From the NVFC: The House of Representatives will be voting on S. 870, The Fire Grants and Safety Act, to reauthorize AFG, SAFER and the U.S. Fire Administration the week of May 6. It is critical that you

--OSHA Proposed Standard: NVFC Issues Statement, Offers Resources for Comments

"The Occupational Safety and Health Administration is replacing its 44-year-old Fire Brigade Standard with the proposed new Emergency Response Standard. While the National Volunteer Fire Council (NVFC) agrees that several of the proposed provisions would be helpful and improve the safety of emergency responders, we are opposed to the implementation of the rule in its current state as it will place new requirements on emergency service organizations that would be impossible for many volunteer departments to fully comply with." *Call to Action:* "We are sounding the alarm for all firefighters, EMS providers, and their communities to flood the public comment portal by the June 21 deadline to let OSHA and our elected officials know that this proposal would have disastrous effects on your communities." **READ CALL TO ACTION**
